Her work as both an artist and educator has earned national recognition, including a 2024 DownBeat Award for Vocal Jazz Soloist and a finalist invitation to the American Traditions Vocal Competition in Savannah, Georgia and the NextGen Vocal Competition at Jazz at Lincoln Center, reflecting her ongoing commitment to originality, excellence, and artistic growth
